  - Must be a resident of no more than 50 km from the city boundaries
  - Must sign Acknowledgement and agree to be bound by the “Code of Ethics” and “Oath of Confidentiality”
  - Must be a full member of the Corporation
- Must not be in bankruptcy and supply a “Declaration of No Undischarged Bankrupt”
  - Must supply a current CPIC that is satisfactory within three months
