- 4. As a member of the Thunder Bay Indigenous Friendship Centre, I will support and work toward the stated aims and objectives of the organization.
- 5. As a member of the Indian Youth Friendship Society, I will at all times conduct myself in a manner that brings respect and credibility to the Indian Youth Friendship Society.
- 6. As a member of the Thunder Bay Indigenous Friendship Centre, at no time will I say or do anything that might appear to discredit the Thunder Bay Indigenous Friendship Centre.
